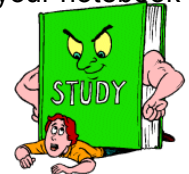

Another consequence of this is that now, children have not more contact with their grandparents. They can not grow up by listening to old stories, having to see what it means taking care of someone. We are lacking lots of values with this new way of living.
